

RESIDENT INPUT SUMMARY

7/20/16 to 8/15/16

Old Business

- 4/19 A Brookside Glen resident called to ask about the progress of a weedy area behind his home along Fairfield Drive.
5/18 The area was sprayed with a broadleaf weed herbicide.
6/2, 6/30, 7/21, 8/4 The area was mowed at the lowest possible setting and string trimmed.
Week of 8/15 The area is scheduled to be seeded and hydro-mulched.
- 6/27 A White Oak resident called to inform us that the District's mowing contractor had missed an area. Staff verified that the area was missed near the north pond, and called the contractor. The resident was called and thanked for providing the information.
7/20 The resident emailed that the area had been missed by the mowing contractor. The contractor was called and a message was left.
8/1 The resident called and spoke with staff, stating that the contractor was onsite and was not mowing the area in question. Staff immediately went to White Oak Park and spoke with the contracted staff, showed them the spot, spoke with the contractor owner on the phone, and verified that this spot would not be missed again.

New Business

- 7/21 A bicyclist called to inform us that the bike path transition at Walnut Creek Drive and Pfeiffer Road, bridging over Union Ditch has a difficult drop/step.
7/22 Staff called and spoke to the bicyclist to inform him that the path was under the maintenance responsibility of the surrounding condo association who has worked with the Village of Frankfort in regards to the bridge.
- 7/25 Frankfort Square Wildcats requested additional garbage cans and porta potties be provided for football camp. Garbage cans and porta potties were delivered by the end of the day.
- 7/25 Frankfort Square Wildcats requested that loose flaking paint be scraped from ceiling in the concession stand and storage area and be repainted. This project was scheduled and completed on 8/3.
