

LWSRA Board Report

Highlights from the November 20, 2018 Board Meeting include:

- The LWSRA/Heather Glen Homeowners Trick or Trot 5K race was held on October 20 with 81 runners. Over \$2,000 was raised for the universal design playground.
- The 7th Annual Trunk or Treat was held on October 27 with 21 volunteer trunks. 450+ children attended.
- The target date to begin the sensory room project is December 3, 2018.
- Public event – Lunch with the Grinch is scheduled for Saturday, December 15.
- LWSRA will be hosting the National Women's Basketball Tournament and the National Junior Wheelchair Basketball Tournament March 29 – 31, 2019. Tournament locations include Lincoln-Way North, Hickory Creek Middle School, Roma, Matteson Community Center, and LWSRA.
- 128 athletes are currently competing in a variety of Special Olympics opportunities – volleyball, floor hockey, swimming, bocce, basketball, and gymnastics.
- The Titans Club is growing with 7 new members, and is working on two community service projects – collecting toys for children and making fleece blankets for the children at the Ronald McDonald House.

FSPD Athletic Supervisor, Matt Tillman, participated in the Turkey Bowl wheelchair football game on November 24 at Lincoln-Way North. This is yet another example of people of all ages and abilities coming together to play and have fun.
